#### **WAIREWA PUBLIC HALL UPDATES**

East Gippsland Shire Council has been working with Wairewa CRC to deliver the following upgrades to the hall:

- **BAL assessment** Completed. Rating is 19.00 (reasonable chance of ember
- **Switchboard emergency power enabling** Completed. Hard wiring paid to connect a Freemasons donated 10kva generator to building
- Ember hardening of buildings The Hall is High Priority class therefore works will be as follows:
  - Install mesh screens over vents
  - •Frame existing sub floor space with battens & cover with colour bond cladding so no gaps between new sub cover and existing structure
  - •Cladding: from ground level up to 400mm, cap and flash existing colour bond so that no gaps are identified between the existing sub floor space and existing structure.
  - •Ext Walls: fill gaps with non-combustible sealant colour matched to existing cladding.
  - Provide metal mesh screens to external doors and door frames utilizing seals to negate smoke entrance to structure.
  - •Replace the external doors and door frames with utilizing seals to negate smoke entrance to structure.
  - •Provide Wire screens covering all windows if normal annealed glazing

EGSC Mayor Cr Mendy Urie will be announcing other vital measures to build resilience into Wairewa Public Hall shortly. The above information was reported to the Wairewa CRC meeting on 29 September by Paul Oakes, Senior Project Officer - Built Environment Recovery. Thank you EGSC.
